Scrip Program – Do not forget to order your Scrip cards for the Holiday shopping season. Several families have also taken advantage of using the Scrip program to offset their educational fees. I personally know of a family who used Scrip gift cards to purchase large amounts of construction and building supplies for a new home which resulted in a nice sum of cash rewards for their child's educational fees. Even that trip to Walmart, Pick N Save or Subway can result in extra cash in your pockets as well as benefiting St. John School. For those of us not using this opportunity, we really are “missing the boat” on saving some of our hard earned money.

INCLEMENT WEATHER-Remember to listen to WHBL (AM1330) or WTMJ (620 AM) when you suspect that bad weather is on its way or has arrived. If you are a TV person, turn to the major network stations (4, 6, 12, 58) to view announcements. If an announcement talks about or shows RANDOM LAKE SCHOOL DISTRICT, that includes us. Whatever Random Lake does, we have to follow because we are dependent on the public bus service. Decisions can range from no school, to late start, to early dismissal. Also remember, that when we have a LATE START, preschool classes will not be held. Finally, use your own good judgment as to whether or not your child will attend school on a bad weather day. The conditions at your home could be quite different than here and visa versa.
