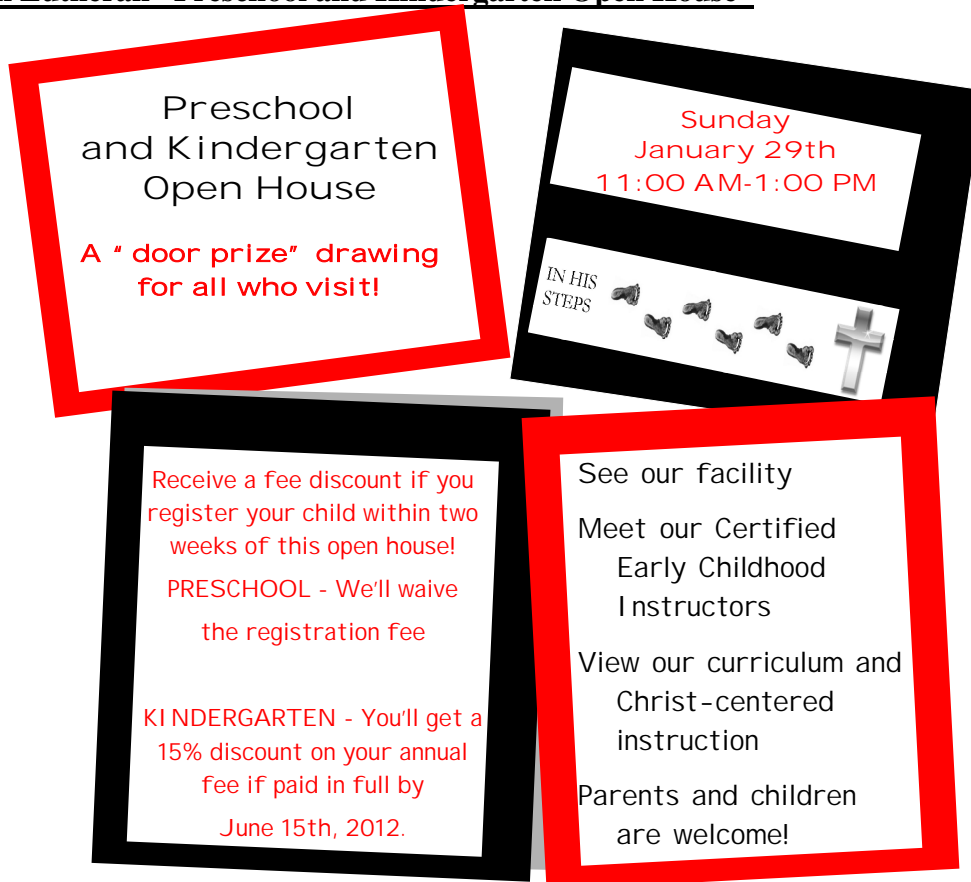
2nd place tie was awarded to Adam Warnock (8) and Kaelynn Maxwell (7).
