From the South Wisconsin District Office:

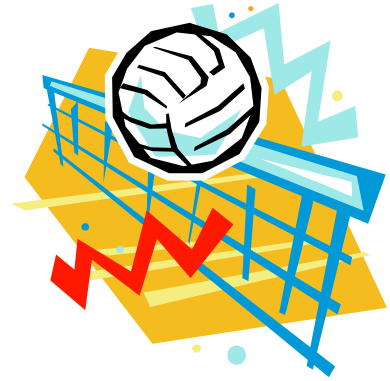
